
Important Safety Instructions

- Always check local ordinances to be sure a fire is allowed in your area before using this product.


Parts


Using Bolts Bolt heads must always face outside the fire pit during assembly.

Each Kite tip must be connected in a specific way.


Spread each of the **STACKS** open to prepare them for assembly as shown.




Bonfireball.



NOTE: As you assemble, insert nuts and bolts but DO NOT TIGHTEN until all stacks have been attached.


















Assemble the **BASE WALLS** into
